### ENERGY ANALYST

The Energy Analyst would provide technical and analytic support and project management for the Hawaii State Energy Office's renewable energy and clean transportation energy functions, program activities and projects in support of achieving of the state's energy goals and policies. Two years of supervisory work experience. One year of the work experience should be in a field related to energy management or conservation.
