1. Applicant locates a person to supervise the experiment who is certified in Category 10, Demonstration and Research Pest Control. The Demonstration and Research Pest Control Certification requires the **Pesticide Application Certification** core examination, plus the Commercial Category 10 Application. Complete the Hawaii Department of Agriculture Experimental Use Permit Application - Pesticides (Form P-35) and submit to HDOA, Division of Plant Industry, Pesticides Branch. 3. HDOA reviews the permit application for completeness and accepts application if complete. 4. HDOA approves (with conditions, e.g. the head may limit the quantity of a Approximately 5 pesticide than what was requested) or denies the application. Permits are days from Step usually effective for one year, depending on the activity, and may be renewed 3 if circumstances warrant. 5. Permit holder submits periodic reports (in intervals prescribed by the head of HDOA) regarding the status of the experimental program. 6. A final report regarding the experiments is submitted to HDOA. Within 6 months after the expiration of the permit
