Noting the Memorandum of Cooperation Creating the Hawaii-Okinawa Partnership on Clean and Efficient Energy Development and Deployment, signed on June 17, 2010 (hereinafter referred to as the "Memorandum"), for an initial five-year term;

Noting the strong desire of the Participants to continue cooperation under the Hawaii-Okinawa Partnership on Clean and Efficient Energy Development and Deployment; and

Acting pursuant to Section 7.1 of the Memorandum;
