

**District Boundary Amendment**  
**Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism**  
**Land Use Commission (LUC)**  
**DBEDT-LUC-1**

**Purpose:** To amend a land use district boundary on land that is within conservation districts, land designated or sought to be designated important agricultural lands, and lands greater than fifteen acres in the agricultural, rural, and urban districts

**Approval Authority:** LUC

**Prerequisite(s):** Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) compliance

**Fees:** \$500

<b>Checklist</b>	<b>Estimated Time</b>
1. Applicant completes an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement.	
2. Applicant submits a petition for a district boundary amendment based on HAR 15-15-6 to LUC.	
3. LUC reviews petition for completeness and accepts petition if complete.	30 days from Petition Submission
4. Notice of Hearing is published.	30 days Prior to Public Hearing
5. Public Hearing on the island on which the subject property is situated.	Between 60 and 180 days from Petition Acceptance
6. LUC approves, approves with conditions, or denies the petition. (Amendment of a district boundary requires approval by at least six of the nine Commissioners.)	
<b>Total Estimated Time from Application Acceptance</b>	<b>365 days</b>
