

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NOTE: This permit is issued only to a person who is licensed to engage in the business of installing or repairing elevators by the Contractors License Board of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, State of Hawaii.

ALSO NOTE: This permit may not be required if already completing a Building Permit through one of the counties in Hawaii.



The application shall be deemed approved if not acted on by the department within thirty working days following the receipt of the application.

Because of permit backlogs, inspections may be completed verbally (over the phone).

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normal hours or \$200 when outside regular working hours. Failure to pay the fees required within sixty days after notification will result in a penalty equal to 50% of the fee.
