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2.	Complete and informally submit Part B – Notification of Regulated Waste Activity (EPA Form 8700-12) as dictated by Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) 11-264 and 11-270.	
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3.	DOH holds public commentary for the permit application.	45 days from Step 2
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4.	DOH holds a pre-permit meeting.	30 days from Step 3
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5.	Applicant formally submits the completed Part A (EPA Form 8700-23) and Part B (EPA Form 8700-12) to DOH, Hazardous Waste Branch.	
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6.	DOH publishes public notice of receipt of the permit application and holds another public review.	30-90 days from Step 5
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7.	Commentary from public review incorporated into final consideration for the permit.	30-90 days from Step 6
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8.	DOH approves (with conditions) or denies the permit.	30 days from Step 7
