Approval or Permit Required: To engage in the construction, expansion, or demolition of buildings, houses, bridges, roadway (including improvements), utilities, reservoirs or any other activity causing excess noise in the community.

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Steps	Time
1. Determine whether planned activity should be considered a “Stationary Activity” or a “Construction Activity” and based on this activity, submit the appropriate application to the Department of Health (DOH).	
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2. If constructing new facility or expanding, repairing, or otherwise modifying an existing facility, must submit a “Notice of Intent” to begin construction	
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3. If applicable, complete and submit a “Noise Variance” application form	
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4. Director of DOH reviews application materials for completeness and accepts application if complete.	
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5. DOH sends written response indicating approval or denial of the permit.	90 days from Item 5

All other construction Activities	\$50	\$50
Operation of stationary noise sources	\$50	\$50
Equipment related to agricultural activities	\$50	\$50
Equipment related to industrial activities	\$50	\$50
Total Fees:	\$25/year (minimum)	\$225/year (maximum)
