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Steps	Time
1. Submit Appropriate Application for UIC action.	6 months prior to construction
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2. If applying to construct a new injection well, an application MUST be submitted under the signature of a geologist or professional engineer.	
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3. Upon satisfactory review of all materials and information, a written approval or denial to begin construction on the injection well will be issued by the Hawai'i Department of Health.	up to 90 days depending on complexity and completeness of the application
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4. Construction of the injection well must be followed by injection testing, the results of which, along with geologic logs and other requested information, must be submitted as a final engineer/geologist report.	
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5. Once the final report is deemed satisfactory, a permit to operate the injection well will be issued.	90 days from Item 4
