

Permit Brief – State of Hawaii – 1
Use of State Lands
State of Hawaii

Reason for Approval/Permit: To request the use of State lands or facilities for access, easement, purchase, lease, license, right of entry, or other permission; **may** include lands or facilities managed or owned by the Hawaii Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR), Department of Transportation (DOT), Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL), Department of Agriculture (DOA), Hawaii Community Development Authority (HCDA), Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS), University of Hawaii (UH) and Department of Education (DOE)

References: Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS); Chapter 13-220, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR)

Fees: Varies upon type of land use and duration; land values may be determined by fair market value appraisal or other method deemed appropriate by the land owner and/or purchaser

Permit Prerequisite(s): HRS 343 compliance (environmental assessment or environmental impact statement)
