# SUPPORT HB 2120 RELATING TO EMERGENCY MANGEMENT.

Chair Ichiyama, Vice Chair Eli and Members of the Committee, the Hawaii State Energy Office (HSEO) **supports** HB 2120, which updates several sections under 127A to reflect current practices, policies, and procedures of the State Emergency Management Program and prevailing emergency management best practices and adds wording that highlights the intent of the State, Governor, and emergency management agencies to address environmental and climate impacts on emergency management.
