The Energy Analyst provides analytical support and project management for the Hawaii State Energy Office's support of energy efficiency activities, programs and policies. Potential projects include, but are not limited to:

- Project management for the planning, design, and support of an energy efficiency program for buildings and operations such as energy performance contracting.
- Project management for conducting meetings and planning sessions on energy efficiency.

Minimum Qualification Requirements:
