TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At TEDxHonolulu events, TEDTalks videos and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection among attendees and presenters. TEDxHonolulu established a Sustainability Team in 2013 as part of its efforts to cultivate community and to share in the collective responsibility to malama aina, both locally—in Hawaii—and globally.
