Complete the appropriate application form based on proposed activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Application for Certificate of Authorization to Fabricate/Repair Non-Boiler External Piping (NBEP)- Application for Repair/Installation of NBEP- Application for Installation Permit (for boilers)- Certificate of Competency Application (for boilers) <p>Submit application; plans and specifications for installation; copies of engineering data, tests, manufacturer's data reports and laboratory reports (if new equipment being installed for the first time in the State of Hawaii); and appropriate fees (see next page) to the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (DLIR), Hawaii Occupational Safety and Health (HIOSH).</p>	
<p>2. HIOSH reviews application for completeness and accepts application if complete.</p>	
<p>3. HIOSH issues an installation permit to a contractor who is licensed to engage in the business of installing or repairing boilers, pressure vessels, or pressure systems by the contractors license board of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, State of Hawaii.</p>	30 days from Step #2
<p>4. After installation, a DLIR, HIOSH inspector reviews the installed system to ensure that the device has met all requirements of Hawaii Administrative Rules §12-220.</p>	
<p>5. Permit to operate is issued or denied.</p>
