- 1. Complete application form DOT 3-009 and submit with all other required information listed below to the appropriate Harbors Division office.
 - a. Tax Map Key (TMK) showing ownership of and adjacent to project site
 - b. Engineer drawings
 - 1. Location of property lines
 - 2. Existing structures
 - 3. Elevations, soundings
 - 4. Locations, dimensions of proposed structure
 - 5. Other pertinent data (i.e., construction schedule, cost estimate)
 - c. Copy of Department of Army permit application
 - d. A \$50 non-refundable filing fee
- 2. DOT, Harbors Division reviews application for completeness and accepts application if complete.
- 3. The Harbors Division submits the application to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, the Hawaii Department of Health, and DLNR for review.
- 4. After agreement from the departments listed in Step #3, the Harbors Division will accept, accept with modification, or reject the application.
