



Hawaii's Petroleum Use (Gallons By Sector)




- Ground Transportation (28%)



Bikeshare Hawai'i

The bikeshare collaborative and working group is proud to announce the launch of Bikeshare Hawai'i, a newly formed non-profit organization responsible for overseeing bikeshare in the State of Hawai'i. Bikesharing acts as a public transportation system that enables its customers to make short trips between a network of unattended bike docking stations. Bikeshare is growing rapidly around the world and is in place or expected to launch in most major U.S. cities in the next few years. The nonprofit will work with public and private partners to manage the launch and operations of a bikeshare system in Hawai'i. The initial system roll out will focus in urban Honolulu with the vision of expanding the service statewide.
