



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Aqua Blue Foundation



Aqua has created a foundation called Aqua Blue. It's mission is to support the Pacific Ocean ecosystem and the greater Hawaiian Islands environment and the foundation is dedicated to a healthy Pacific Ocean and to protecting and preserving the millions of species that rely on the ocean. This includes supporting a healthy ecosystem for fish, birds and mammals that are being impacted by changes to the environment, as well as reefs and plants that feed a healthy ocean and sustain the food chain.

Aqua Blue Foundation will focus on areas of life directly connected to the Pacific, most notably those islands that are in need of cleanup or restoration to help support the health of the ocean. This includes supporting the marine reserve efforts such as the Papahānaumokuākea Marine National Monument created in 2006, the ongoing efforts to clean Midway and other islands so that they can thrive as bird or fish sanctuaries, and efforts to promote awareness and support of these activities. Aqua will infuse the latter into its guest services and programs, creating opportunities for our guests and our team members to participate in the foundation.

Aqua Bamboo Waikiki

- **Hotel built in 1968**
- **96 total rooms**
- **2 elevators**
- **12 floors**
- **In-room appliances include microwaves, mini-refrigerators, full sized refrigerators, two burner stoves, full stoves with oven, coffee makers, alarm clocks, flat screen LCD TV, air conditioning**
- **Common areas include air conditioned lobby, saltwater pool, coin-op guest laundry, café, guest parking area.**



Existing Initiatives

- **CFL or LED light fixtures**
 - Forward initiative to remove all lighting that utilize ballasts
- **Energy Star-rated appliances in unit**
- **Low flush toilets, urinals, and shower heads**
- **Reduced sink aerators to .7 GPM**
- **Guest and team member recycling program**
- **Internal power saving policies**
- **Low wattage hand dryers in common area restrooms**



Added Initiatives

- **Reduced water level in hotel laundry commercial washers**
- **Hand-watering of plants**
- **Drought resistant plants**
- **Wood chips in planters**
- **Towel re-use program in guest rooms**
- **Dry spill kit station**



Electronic Room Key System

- **Wireless room EMS (Energy Management System)**
- **Self powered**
- **Widely used throughout Asia & Europe**
- **User friendly**
- **Guest participation**
- **Implemented January 2014**



What Are the RESULTS?

Because our system is newly-installed with limited measurable data, we anticipate a savings of about 30-35% for the individual rooms resulting in a 15-25% reduction in the total building kilowatt usage.
