A FEDERAL-STATE-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP WORKING TOWARD 70% CLEAN ENERGY BY 2030

A 2008 Memorandum of Understanding established a long-term partnership between the State of Hawai'i and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). The Hawai'i Clean Energy Initiative (HCEI) is a result of this partnership and brings together federal, state, and private stakeholders in an effort to achieve 70% clean energy by 2030 with 30% from efficiency measures, and 40% coming from local renewable energy sources. The HCEI also identifies a goal of 70% reduction in oil use for ground transportation.
