Provides COMMENTS on SB 143

RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.

Chair Gabbard, Vice Chair Richards, and Members of the Committee, the Hawaii State Energy Office (HSEO) supports the intent of SB 143 which requires self-service stations to put labels on gas dispensing equipment that advise consumers on the effects of fossil fuel consumption to human health and the environment.

HSEO appreciates increasing public awareness of the harmful effects of the burning of fossil fuels on human health and the environment with a desired outcome of decreased fossil fuel usage which supports the State's clean energy goals.
