STEP 1: CHECKLIST

The checklist helps to assess your business's green attributes and practices.

1. Go to the HGBP website and download the checklist:
greenbusiness.hawaii.gov/apply
2. Fill out the checklist and submit electronically to:
dbedt.hgbp@hawaii.gov
3. Your HGBP coordinator will notify you if you may proceed to the next step.



STEP 2: SITE VISIT

Depending on the results from your Checklist, a site visit may be scheduled.

Working in coordination with Board of Water Supply and Dept. of Health, an auditor will contact and work with your business to verify your responses to your Checklist with an in-person Site Visit.

STEP 3: GET RECOGNIZED

After all steps are completed, applicants will be eligible for recognition as a Hawai'i Green Business by the Governor. Businesses are then encouraged to display the Hawai'i Green Business Program logo, promote networking opportunities, public relations, and to increase public awareness.
